## 10 SECTION 4. PREPLANNING FUNDS - REIMBURSEMENT TO GENERAL FUND.

11 The \$100,000 appropriated for preplanning costs for the new veterans' home in section 3 of this

12 Act is to be included as part of the overall cost of the construction project and the veterans'

13 home is to reimburse the general fund the \$100,000 prior to June 30, 2009, from federal

- 14 matching funds available for this project.
- 15 SECTION 5. ONE-TIME FUNDING EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET REPORT TO

16 SIXTY-FIRST LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The total general fund appropriation in section 3 of 17 this Act includes \$265,700 for the veterans' home and \$59,606 for the department of veterans' 18 affairs for the one-time funding items identified in this section. This amount is not a part of the 19 agencies' base budgets to be used in preparing the 2009-11 executive budget. The veterans' 20 home and department of veterans' affairs shall report to the appropriations committees of the 21 sixty-first legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning 22 July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. 23 \$265,700 Life safety improvements and preplanning
