SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and

- 1 other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency,
- 2 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, as follows:

SECTION 4. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER. The less estimated income line item in section 3 of this Act includes the sum of \$4,200,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

SECTION 5. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS. Each patrol officer of the state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 3 of this Act an amount not to exceed one hundred seventy dollars per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses, except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at their respective home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same manner as salaries are paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the presentation of receipts or other memorandums.

SECTION 6. SALARY EQUITY POOL - EFFECT ON SHARE OF STATEWIDE

- **EQUITY POOL.** The general fund appropriation included in section 3 of this Act includes \$200,000 of additional funding for salary equity adjustments for troopers and sergeants. The human resource management services division of the office of management and budget may not consider this additional funding in its calculation of the highway patrol's share of the statewide salary equity pool for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
- SECTION 7. ONE-TIME FUNDING EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET REPORT TO SIXTY-FIRST LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The total general fund appropriation line item in section 3 of this Act includes \$842,000 for the one-time funding items identified in this section.

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- 1 This amount is not a part of the agency's base budget to be used in preparing the 2009-11
- 2 executive budget. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committees of the
- 3 sixty-first legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning
- 4 July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
