22	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
23	amended and reenacted as follows:		
24	54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state. The annual salary of the	e secretary of state is	
25	seventy seventy-six thousand seven five hundred thirty-nine eleven dollars through June 30,		
26	2006 2008, and seventy-three seventy-nine thousand five hundred sixty-eight seventy-one		
27	dollars thereafter.
