1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of

2 public instruction, the school for the deaf, North Dakota vision services - school for the blind,

3 and the state library; to provide for the distribution of special education payments; and to amend

4 and reenact section 15.1-02-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the

5 superintendent of public instruction.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this
section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the department of public
instruction, the school for the deaf, North Dakota vision services - school for the blind, and the
state library in section 3 of this Act as follows:

21	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the	e general fund in the state
22	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and	
23	other income, to the department of public instruction, the school for the deaf, North Dakota	
24	vision services - school for the blind, and the state library for the purpose of defraying the	
25	expenses of those agencies, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30,

6 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - TUITION APPORTIONMENT. The sum of 7 \$76,200,000, included in the grants - state school aid line item in subdivision 1 of section 3 of 8 this Act, is from the state tuition fund in the state treasury. Any additional amount in the state 9 tuition fund that becomes available for distribution to public schools is appropriated to the 10 department of public instruction for that purpose for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and 11 ending June 30, 2009.

SECTION 5. STATE SCHOOL AID AND SPECIAL EDUCATION EXPENDITURE
 AUTHORITY. The superintendent of public instruction may expend funds included in the grants
 state school aid and grants - special education contracts line items in subdivision 1 of
 section 3 of this Act in payment of grants for educational services that were due in the 2005-07
 biennium but which were not filed, claimed, or properly supported by the education provider
 until after June 30, 2007.

18 SECTION 6. DISTRIBUTION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION AID. The sum of \$400,000, 19 included in the grants - state school aid line item in subdivision 1 of section 3 of this Act, must 20 be distributed to reimburse school districts or special education units for gifted and talented 21 programs upon the submission of an application that is approved in accordance with guidelines 22 adopted by the superintendent of public instruction. The superintendent of public instruction 23 shall encourage cooperative efforts for gifted and talented programs among school districts and 24 special education units. State school aid payments for special education must be reduced by 25 the amount of matching funds required to be paid by school districts or special education units 26 for students participating in the medicaid program. Special education funds equal to the 27 amount of the matching funds required to be paid by the school district or special education unit 28 must be paid by the superintendent of public instruction to the department of human services on 29 behalf of the school district or unit.

SECTION 7. PAYMENTS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNER STUDENTS.

31 Payments to school districts educating English language learner students, as provided in

1 section 15.1-27-12, must be made by the superintendent of public instruction during the

2 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, using up to \$650,000 of the

amount included in the grants - state school aid line item in subdivision 1 of section 3 of this
Act.

5 SECTION 8. INDIRECT COST ALLOCATION. Notwithstanding section 54-44.1-15,
6 the department of public instruction may deposit indirect cost recoveries in its operating
7 account.

8 **SECTION 9. STATE AID TO PUBLIC LIBRARIES.** The line item entitled grants in 9 subdivision 2 of section 3 of this Act includes \$1,200,000 for aid to public libraries, of which no 10 more than one-half is to be expended during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008.

SECTION 10. FEES DEPOSITED IN VISION SERVICES - SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND
 OPERATING FUND. Any moneys included in the estimated income line item in subdivision 4
 of section 3 of this Act, collected for subscription fees or braille fees, must be deposited in the
 North Dakota vision services - school for the blind operating fund in the state treasury and may
 be spent subject to appropriation by the legislative assembly.
 SECTION 11. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-02-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

15.1-02-02. Salary. The annual salary of the superintendent of public instruction is
 eighty eighty-seven thousand five one hundred thirty-one three dollars through June 30, 2006
 2008, and eighty-three ninety thousand seven five hundred fifty-three eighty-seven dollars
 thereafter.
