1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 43-15-01 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to pharmacist administration of immunizations and vaccinations to
3 minors.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 43-15-01 of the North Dakota
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 1. "Administration" means the direct application of a drug to the body of a patient.

8 a. The term includes:

9 (1) The emergency maintenance of a drug delivery device used in home
10 infusion therapy by a qualified home pharmacist when nursing service
11 is not available;

12 (2) Upon an order by a physician or nurse practitioner authorized to
13 prescribe such a drug or by written protocol with a physician or nurse
14 practitioner:

15 (a) Immunization and vaccination by injection of an individual who is
16 more than ~~eighteen~~ eleven years of age, ~~upon an order by a~~
17 ~~physician or nurse practitioner authorized to prescribe such a~~
18 ~~drug or by written protocol with a physician or nurse practitioner;~~
19 and

20 (b) Influenza vaccination by injection of an individual who is more
21 than five years of age; and

22 (3) Provision of drugs by subcutaneous, intradermal, and intramuscular
23 injection to an individual who is more than eighteen years of age upon

1 the order of a physician or nurse practitioner authorized to prescribe
2 such a drug.

3 b. The term does not include the regular ongoing delivery of a drug to the patient
4 in a health care setting and other parenteral administration of a drug.
