- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the veterans' home
- 2 and department of veterans' affairs; to provide an exception to the moratorium on expansion of
- 3 basic care bed capacity; and to provide legislative intent.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

- 1 The 2009-11 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the agencies' base budget for the
- 2 2011-13 biennium. The veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs shall report to the
- 3 appropriations committees of the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time
- 4 funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
- 5 SECTION 3. EXCEPTION TO THE MORATORIUM ON EXPANSION OF BASIC
- 6 CARE BED CAPACITY. Notwithstanding North Dakota Century Code section 23-09.3-01.1,
- 7 after completion of the veterans' home construction project, the veterans' home may add one
- 8 bed to its licensed basic care facility capacity. This one bed is in addition to the authority
- 9 granted the veterans' home in section 3 of chapter 55 of the 2007 Session Laws relating to
- 10 converting fourteen beds from licensed basic care beds to licensed nursing facility beds and
- 11 provides for a total of ninety-eight basic care beds and fifty-two licensed nursing facility beds.
- 12 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS
- 13 AUTHORIZED FOR THE NEW VETERANS' HOME FACILITY. It is the intent of the sixty-first
- 14 legislative assembly that the veterans' home not fill any of the twenty-four full-time equivalent
- 15 positions for the new veterans' home authorized in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act prior to
- 16 June 1, 2010.
