3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000, or so much of the
sum as may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of holding
"stand down" events to coordinate benefits and provide services to needy veterans in this state
for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. This Act is not subject to
section 54-44.1-11. This amount is one-time funding and is not a part of the agency's base
budget for the 2013-15 biennium. The department of veterans' affairs shall report to the
appropriations committees of the sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time
funding. The department of veterans' affairs may not spend any funds appropriated under this
section without prior approval by the state treasurer of an accounting of proposed expenditures
The department of veterans' affairs may only provide funding for a "stand down" event to the
extent private matching funds are used to provide a dollar-for-dollar or in-kind match. The
department of veterans' affairs may not spend more than five thousand dollars for a single
"stand down" event.
