- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the veterans' home
- 2 and department of veterans' affairs; to create and enact a new section to chapter 37-15 of the
- 3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to a memorial fund; and to provide for legislative
- 4 management studies.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

10	There is created in the state treasury the	Melvin Norgard memorial fund. Al	I income related		
11	to a bequest made to the veterans' home by	Melvin Norgard, including mineral	lease income,		
12	royalties, and sale proceeds, must be transfe	rred or deposited into the Melvin N	<u>lorgard</u>		
13	memorial fund. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the state treasurer shall invest				
14	moneys in the fund in accordance with section 21-10-07. Investment income of the fund must				
15	be retained in the fund. Moneys in the fund are available, subject to legislative appropriations,				
16	for projects and programs to benefit and serv	re the residents of the veterans' ho	me. The		
17	legislative assembly shall consider recomme	ndations of the governing board of	the veterans'		
18	home when determining appropriations from	this fund for projects and program	s to benefit and		
19	serve the residents of the veterans' home.				
20	SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEM	ENT STUDY - DISPOSITION OF	THE OLD		
21	VETERANS' HOME FACILITY. During the 20	011-12 interim, the legislative man	agement shall		
22	consider studying all available options, include	ling demolition, for the disposition	of the old		
23	veterans' home facility. The legislative manag	gement shall report its findings and	i		
24	recommendations, together with any legislation	on required to implement the reco	mmendations, to		
25	the sixty-third legislative assembly.				
26	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEM	ENT STUDY - DELIVERY OF SEF	RVICES TO

28	the delivery of services to veterans, including	the consistency in training and of	the provision of		
29	services by county veterans' service officers. The legislative management shall report its
