## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1011

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol;  
2 and to provide for a legislative management study.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
7 other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway  
8 patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

1       **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

2       **SIXTY-THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding  
3 items approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly for the 2009-11 biennium and the 2011-13  
4 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

17 The 2011-13 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the  
18 2013-15 biennium. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committees of the  
19 sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning  
20 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

21       **SECTION 3. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER.** The less estimated income line item in  
22 section 1 of this Act includes the sum of ~~\$4,849,220~~\$5,025,762, or so much of the sum as may  
23 be necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the  
24 direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses  
25 of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

26       **SECTION 4. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS.** Each patrol officer of the  
27 highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an amount  
28 not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30,  
29 2013. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses, except  
30 lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at their respective home  
31 stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same manner as salaries are paid to

1 members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the presentation of receipts or other  
2 memorandums.

3 **SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - HIGHWAY PATROL TRAINING**

4 **ACADEMY.** During the 2011-12 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the  
5 feasibility and desirability of relocating the highway patrol training academy or portions of the  
6 training academy. The study, if conducted, must review options for relocating the training  
7 academy, options for relocating the emergency operations vehicle training course, and options  
8 for constructing a highway patrol shooting range. The legislative management shall report its  
9 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation needed to implement the  
10 recommendations, to the sixty-third legislative assembly.
