MR. PRESIDENT: I wish to congratulate the South Border Mustangs wrestling team for winning the 2013 Class B wrestling championship in Fargo this past weekend. South Border is a co-op of Ashley and Wishek and Zeeland students. They won the individual championship with 195 points, and also won the dual championship as a team beating a strong Linton-HMB squad in the finals. Some of these students are in the chamber today. Particular congratulations go to senior Blake Bosch of Wishek who set a new record for North Dakota by reaching a total of 240 wins over his wrestling career, which includes being a three time state champion and going undefeated the last two years and being named Class B Wrestler of the Year.
