- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 5-03-08 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the deposit of wholesale liquor tax collections; to create a substance abuse
- 3 prevention grant fund; and to provide an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 5-03-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 5-03-08. Taxes and fees deposited in the general fund <u>and substance</u> abuse
- 8 prevention grant fund.
- AllSeventy-five percent of moneys collected by the tax commissioner under this chapter
 must be transferred to the state treasurer, within ten days after the end of the month in which
 they were collected, and deposited in the state general fund. Twenty-five percent of the moneys
 collected must be deposited in the substance abuse prevention grant fund.
- SECTION 2. SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION GRANT FUND. There is created in the state treasury a substance abuse prevention grant fund. Moneys in the fund are available, subject to legislative appropriations, for substance abuse prevention programs.
 - **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the substance abuse prevention grant fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$4,688,500, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of providing competitive grants for substance abuse prevention, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
