7 accountable system of education plays in preparing students to be successful adults in a global
8 economy; and

9 **WHEREAS**, this state has a multitude of high-quality public schools, nonpublic schools, and
10 home schools; and

11 **WHEREAS**, educational variety not only helps to diversify our economy, but also enhances
12 the vibrancy of our state; and

13 **WHEREAS**, this state has many high-quality teachers in public schools, private schools,
14 and home schools, who are committed to educating students; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the vital cause of education reform is one that transcends ideology and political
16 affiliation; and

17 **WHEREAS**, research demonstrates conclusively that providing children with multiple
18 schooling options improves academic performance; and

19 **WHEREAS**, School Choice Week is a nationally celebrated event during which legislators
20 and elected officials can join with millions of parents, teachers, schools, and organizations to
21 raise awareness of the need for effective educational options that challenge and motivate all our
22 students to succeed;
