- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-05-15 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the renewal of licenses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-05-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 43-05-15. Renewal of license - Fee - Established by board - Failure to pay -

7 Reinstatement.

8 Each licensed and practicing podiatrist shall pay the annual renewal license fee established 9 by the board. The license fee may be increased in accordance with the number of years 10 licensed and practicing in North Dakota, but may not exceed five hundred dollars. The fee must 11 be paid on or before the renewal date established by the board. The person is entitled to an 12 annual certificate or license upon payment of the fee. If the renewal fee is not paid within six 13 months after the date established by the board, the license of the delinquent licensee must shall 14 be considered expired and may be revoked and may not be reissued except upon a new 15 application and the payment of the renewal fee established by the board plus twenty-five-16 dollars the late fee established by the board not to exceed more than two times the amount of 17 the renewal feetwo hundred fifty dollars and the costs of any hearing held concerning

18 revocation of a license for nonpayment.
