1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 50-24.4-29 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to geropsychiatric facilities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 50-24.4-29 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **50-24.4-29**. Limits on geropsychiatricGeropsychiatric facilities.

7 Only two<u>The department may select one or more</u> nursing homes within the state may

8 have<u>to operate</u> a unit that exclusively provides geropsychiatric services and no more than one-

9 geropsychiatric unit may be located in any one nursing home. Admission to one of the nursing

10 homes that exclusively provides geropsychiatric services for the purpose of receiving

11 geropsychiatric services may be granted only after the state hospital has performed an

12 evaluation of the individual being admitted which indicates the individual is in need of nursing

13 home geropsychiatric services. If at any time the department determines that the number of

- 14 approved geropsychiatric units in the state is below two insufficient to meet the needs, the
- 15 department may select a geropsychiatric unit based on the experience, qualification, and
- 16 capacity of the nursing homes that propose to provide geropsychiatric services. After the-
- 17 geropsychiatric units have been established within the nursing homes, the <u>The</u> state hospital
- 18 may not offer geropsychiatric services through any other geropsychiatrica unit set up exclusively
- 19 to provide those services.
