3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6

treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of

7 defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,

8 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:
