

Introduced by

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century  
2 Code, relating to an evidence-based alcohol and drug education program; to amend and  
3 reenact subsection 3 of section 5-01-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a penalty  
4 for individuals under twenty-one years of age using alcoholic beverages or entering licensed  
5 premises; and to provide appropriations to the department of human services.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created  
8 and enacted as follows:

9 **Department of human services - Alcohol and drug education program.**

10 The department of human services shall administer an evidence-based alcohol and drug  
11 education program for individuals under the age of twenty-one in violation of section 5-01-08.

12 The department may charge a fee to a participant in the program.

13 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 5-01-08 of the North Dakota Century  
14 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15 3. A violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor. For a violation of subsection 2,  
16 the court also shall sentence a violator to evidence-based alcohol and drug education  
17 administered by the department of human services.

18 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - ALCOHOL**

19 **AND DRUG EDUCATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the  
20 state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_, or so much of the  
21 sum as may be necessary, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income,  
22 the sum of \_\_\_\_\_, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department  
23 of human services for the purpose of administering an evidence-based alcohol and drug

1 education program for individuals under the age of twenty-one in violation of section 5-01-08,  
2 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

3 **SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - CHILDRENS'**  
4 **PREVENTION AND EARLY INTERVENTION BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES.** There is  
5 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise  
6 appropriated, the sum of \$978,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the  
7 department of human services for the purpose of providing grants to peer support organizations  
8 that provide prevention and early intervention behavioral health services for children, including  
9 services to children suffering from toxic stress resulting from trauma and violence, for the  
10 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. Services must be made available  
11 in both rural and urban areas of the state.

12 **SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - BEHAVIORAL**  
13 **HEALTH DATABASE.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
14 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$70,000, or so much of the sum as may be  
15 necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of providing a grant to an  
16 organization administering statewide 2-1-1 services to create a behavioral health provider  
17 database of profit and nonprofit organizations, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and  
18 ending June 30, 2019.

19 **SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES -**  
20 **PEER-TO-PEER AND FAMILY-TO-FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES.** There is appropriated out  
21 of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of  
22 \$960,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services  
23 for the purpose of providing a grant to a statewide peer-to-peer or family-to-family support  
24 organization, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. Grant funds  
25 awarded must be used for providing recovery and peer support services to individuals with  
26 emotional, behavioral, or mental health needs.

27 **SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - PRIVATE**  
28 **PROVIDER CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the  
29 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_, or  
30 so much of the sum as may be necessary, and from special funds derived from federal funds  
31 and other income, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_, or so much of the sum as may be necessary,

- 1 to the department of human services for the purpose of allowing private provider case
- 2 management services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
