1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 60-02-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to public warehouse licenses; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 60-02-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **60-02-07. Public warehouse license - ~~How obtained~~ - Fee - Financial statement.**

7 ~~An annual~~ A license must be obtained from the commission for each public warehouse in
8 operation in this state. ~~The license expires on July thirty-first of each year.~~

9 1. a. The commission shall stagger by lot the expiration date of all licenses issued for
10 the period beginning August 1, 2015, so that one-half of all the licenses issued
11 expire on July 31, 2016, and one-half of all the licenses issued expire on July 31,
12 2017. Thereafter, all licenses issued under this section must be for a period of
13 two years and terminate on the thirty-first day of July in the year of expiration.

14 b. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision a, the commission shall
15 license a warehouse annually, for the first six years of the warehouse's
16 operation.

17 (2) An initial annual license application that becomes effective on or after June
18 first does not expire until July thirty-first of the following calendar year.

19 2. No license may describe more than one public warehouse nor grant permission to
20 operate any public warehouse other than the one described.

21 3. a. The annual license fee for a public warehouse is ~~three~~;

22 (1) ~~Three~~ hundred dollars for a warehouse ~~of a bushel~~ having a maximum
23 capacity of two hundred thousand ~~bushels~~ [7047.8 cubic meters] ~~or less,~~
24 four;

- 1 (2) ~~Four~~ Four hundred fifty dollars for a warehouse ~~of a bushel~~having a capacity of
2 more than two hundred thousand ~~and~~bushels [7047.8 cubic meters] but not
3 more than five hundred thousand ~~bushels [7047.8 to not more than~~
4 17619.54 cubic meters];~~;~~ and five
5 (3) ~~Five~~ Five hundred fifty dollars for a warehouse ~~of a bushel~~having a capacity of
6 more than five hundred thousand ~~bushels [17619.54 cubic meters]~~.
7 b. The biennial license fee for a public warehouse is:
8 (1) Six hundred dollars for a warehouse having a maximum capacity of two
9 hundred thousand bushels [7047.8 cubic meters];
10 (2) Nine hundred dollars for a warehouse having a capacity of more than two
11 hundred thousand bushels [7047.8 cubic meters] but not more than five
12 hundred thousand bushels [17619.54 cubic meters]; and
13 (3) One thousand one hundred dollars for a warehouse having a capacity of
14 more than five hundred thousand bushels [17619.54 cubic meters].
15 c. ~~A license renewal~~An application for an annual license renewal that is received
16 after July fifteenth ~~must be assessed~~include an additional one hundred dollar fee
17 per warehouse. ~~An application for a biennial license renewal that is received after~~
18 July fifteenth must include an additional two hundred dollar fee per warehouse.
19 4. If a public warehouseman operates two or more warehouses in the same city or
20 siding, in conjunction with each other and with the same working force, and keeps one
21 set of books and records for all such warehouses, and issues one series of scale
22 tickets, warehouse receipts, checks, and credit-sale contracts for the grain stored and
23 purchased therein, only one license is required for the operation of all such
24 warehouses. When two or more warehouses are operated under one license, the
25 license fee is based upon the combined bushel capacity of the warehouses.~~If the~~
26 ~~commission employs fewer than two full-time equivalent warehouse inspectors, each~~
27 ~~annual fee under this section is reduced by one hundred dollars.~~
28 5. If required to obtain United States department of agriculture approval of the
29 commission's warehouse inspection program, the commission may require that the
30 applicant submit a current financial statement prepared in accordance with generally

- 1 accepted accounting principles. A financial statement furnished under this
- 2 section subsection is a confidential trade secret and is not a public record.
- 3 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
