- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-31 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to prohibiting the wearing of masks, hoods, and face coverings at certain
- 3 functions; and to provide a penalty.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-31 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Wearing of masks at certain functions prohibited Exceptions.
- 8 <u>1.</u> An individual, with the intent to conceal that individual's identity, may not wear a mask,
- 9 <u>hood, or other device that covers, hides, or conceals any portion of that individual's</u>
- 10 <u>face while:</u>
- 11 <u>a. Entering, being, or appearing on any lane, walkway, alley, street, road, highway,</u>
  12 <u>or other public way;</u>
- b. Entering, appearing on, or within the public property of the state or of any political subdivision; or
- 15 <u>c. Holding any meeting or demonstration on the private property of another unless</u>
   written permission has been obtained from the owner or occupant of the property.
- 17 <u>2. This section does not apply to an individual:</u>
- 18 <u>a. Under the age of seventeen;</u>
- 19 <u>b.</u> <u>Wearing a traditional holiday costume in season;</u>
- 20 <u>c. Engaged in trade and employment or in a sporting activity at which a mask is</u>
- 21 worn for the purpose of ensuring the physical safety of the wearer, or because of
- 22 <u>the nature of the occupation, trade, profession, or sporting activity;</u>
- d. Using a mask in a theatrical production or masquerade ball;
- 24 <u>e. Wearing a mask prescribed for civil defense drills, exercises, or emergencies;</u>

1 Engaged in a parade, ceremony, or celebration; 2 Wearing a mask, hood, or device for the purpose of providing protection from the g. 3 elements; or 4 Wearing a mask or other covering based on religious beliefs. <u>h.</u> 5 As used in this section: <u>3.</u> 6 "Demonstration" means marching, congregating, standing, parading, <u>a.</u> 7 demonstrating, or patrolling by an individual, with or without signs, for the 8 purpose of persuading others or the public, or to protest some action, attitude, or 9 belief. 10 "Mask" means a covering for the face or part of the face disguising the wearer. <u>b.</u> 11 A violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor.
