1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to the employment of individuals under twenty-one years of age at
3 establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 6 of section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota Century
6 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 6. ~~An~~A restaurant may employ an individual who is eighteen years of age or older but
8 under twenty-one years of age ~~may be employed by a restaurant~~ as provided in
9 subsection ~~23~~ to serve and collect money for alcoholic beverages, if the individual is
10 under the direct supervision of an individual twenty-one or more years of age, but may
11 not be engaged in mixing, dispensing, or consuming alcoholic beverages. Any
12 establishment ~~where~~that sells alcoholic beverages ~~are sold~~ may employ ~~individuals~~an
13 individual from eighteen to twenty-one years of age to work ~~in the capacity of~~
14 ~~musicians~~on the premises as a musician, disc jockey, or entertainer, or to perform
15 duties directly related to working as a musician, disc jockey, or entertainer if the
16 individual is under the direct supervision of an individual twenty-one or more years of
17 age.
