1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of carbon monoxide alarms.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS.**

4 During the 2017-18 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the fire code
5 and how the existing regulations apply to carbon monoxide alarms, the need for residential
6 rental property to be equipped with carbon monoxide alarms, and the costs associated with
7 installing carbon monoxide alarms in residential rental property. The study must include the
8 types of education and outreach being used by local fire departments to educate communities
9 and school children about the dangers of carbon monoxide poisoning. The legislative
10 management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation
11 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-sixth legislative assembly.
