1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of the creation of a college  
2 tuition waiver or reimbursement program.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - SENIOR TUITION WAIVER OR**  
5 **REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM.** During the 2017-18 interim, the legislative management shall  
6 consider studying the feasibility and desirability of the development of a state tuition waiver or  
7 reimbursement program for college seniors at institutions of higher education under the control  
8 of the state board of higher education. The study must consider designing a program to waive  
9 or reimburse tuition expenses at these institutions for students who are North Dakota residents  
10 who graduated from a high school in this state or completed a program of home education  
11 supervised in accordance with chapter 15.1-23. The study may include the objectives of a  
12 senior tuition waiver or reimbursement program, the definition of residency for purposes of the  
13 program, the duration of a tuition waiver once a student is designated a senior by the institution,  
14 the necessary funding mechanisms for the program, the maximum total waiver or  
15 reimbursement amounts available to individual students, grade point average requirements,  
16 post-graduation requirements, merit-based requirements, and the effectiveness of tuition  
17 waivers versus post-graduation reimbursement. The legislative management shall report its  
18 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the  
19 recommendations, to the sixty-sixth legislative assembly.
