ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1021

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of workforce safety and
2 insurance.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from the workforce safety
6 and insurance fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to workforce safety and
7 insurance, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

14 **SECTION 2.** The appropriation in Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$775,925 for
15 increases in employee health insurance premiums from \$1,130 to \$1,249 per month.

17 **SIXTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
