1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state department  
2 of health.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
7 other income, to the state department of health for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the  
8 state department of health, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019,  
9 as follows:

1       **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET.** The following amounts  
2 reflect the one-time funding items approved by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly as adjusted  
3 for the 2015-17 biennium:

11       **SECTION 3. ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND.** The estimated  
12 income line item included in section 1 of this Act includes \$250,000, or so much of the sum as  
13 may be necessary, to be made available to the state department of health from the environment  
14 and rangeland protection fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30,  
15 2019. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant to the North Dakota stockmen's association  
16 environmental services program.
