1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 39-06.1-11 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to temporary restricted licenses.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 39-06.1-11 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 3. The director may not issue a temporary restricted license to any offender whose
7 operator's license has been revoked under section 39-20-04 or suspended upon a
8 second or subsequent offense under section 39-08-01 or chapter 39-20, except that a
9 temporary restricted license may be issued in accordance with subsection 7 if the
10 offender is participating in the twenty-four seven sobriety program under chapter 54-12
11 or if the offender has not committed an offense for a period of one year before the date
12 of the filing of a written application. The application must be accompanied by:
- 13 a. Proof of financial responsibility and a report from an appropriate licensed
14 addiction treatment program and, if prescribed, proof of compliance with
15 attendance rules in an appropriate licensed addiction treatment program; or
 - 16 b. If the offender is participating in the drug court program or other court-ordered
17 treatment or sobriety program, a recommendation from the district court.
