AN ACT to provide an appropriation for a shooting sports grant program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - GAME AND FISH SHOOTING SPORTS GRANT PROGRAM.

There is appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$250,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the game and fish department for the purpose of establishing and administering a shooting sports grant program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. The director of the game and fish department may establish a shooting sports grant program, which may be made available to schools, clubs, and organized youth groups in the state. The funds appropriated under this section may be used to provide grants to promote and facilitate shooting sports in schools, clubs, and organized youth groups in the state.
