The bill creates authorization for issuance of discretionary special allocation hunting licenses and amend and repeal relating sections.

This bill will decrease revenue by allowing additional issuance of annual discretionary special allocation hunting licenses to eligible organizations for raffle or auction.

The bill allows for authorization of issuance of not more than: 2 elk, 2 moose, 2 antelope, and 10 white-tailed deer. These are additional licenses authorized by this bill; each license is \$30. The fiscal impact is a decrease in revenue of \$480 per year (Biennium \$960).
