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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 39-06.1-06. Amount of statutory fees.
- The fees required for a noncriminal disposition under section 39-06.1-02 or 39-06.1-03 must be as follows:
 - For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of twenty dollars
 except for a violation of any traffic parking regulation on any state charitable or penal
 institution property or on the state capitol grounds, a fee in the amount of five dollars,
 excluding a violation of subsection 10 of section 39-01-15.
- 14 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except for:
- 16 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, or 39-10-42, a fee of fifty dollars.
- b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02 or section 39-08-23, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one hundred dollars.

1 A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-04-37 by an individual by becoming a 2 resident of this state, a fee of one hundred dollars. 3 g. A violation of subsection 2 of section 39-10-21.1, a fee of two hundred fifty 4 dollars. 5 A violation of section 39-10-59, a fee of one hundred dollars. h. 6 i. A violation of section 39-09-01, a fee of thirty dollars. 7 A violation of section 39-09-01.1, a fee of thirty dollars. j. 8 A violation of section 39-10-46 or 39-10-46.1, a fee of one hundred dollars. k. 9 A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-08-20, one hundred fifty dollars for a first 10 violation and three hundred dollars for a second or subsequent violation in three 11 years. 12 3. For a violation of section 39-21-44 or a rule adopted under that section, a fee of two 13 hundred fifty dollars. 14 Except as provided in subsections 5 and 7 subsection 6, for a violation of section 15 39-09-02, or an equivalent ordinance, a fee established as follows: 16 Miles per hour over 17 lawful speed limit Fee 18 1 - 5 \$ 5 19 6 - 10 \$ 5 plus \$1/each mph over 5 mph over limit 20 11 - 15 \$ 10 plus \$1/each mph over 10 mph over limit 21 16 - 20 \$ 15 plus \$2/each mph over 15 mph over limit 22 21 - 25 \$ 25 plus \$3/each mph over 20 mph over limit 23 26 - 35 \$ 40 plus \$3/each mph over 25 mph over limit 24 36 - 45 \$ 70 plus \$3/each mph over 35 mph over limit 25 46 + \$100 plus \$5/each mph over 45 mph over limit 26 5. On a highway on which the speed limit is a speed higher than fifty-five miles 27 [88.51 kilometers] an hour, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or an equivalent 28 ordinance, a fee established as follows: 29 Miles per hour over 30 Fee lawful speed limit 31 1 - 10\$2/each mph over limit

2	6.	For a violation of subsection 3 of section 39-21-46, a fee established as follows:
3		a. Driving more than eleven hours since the last ten hours off duty, driving after
4		fourteen hours on duty since the last ten hours off duty, driving after sixty hours
5		on duty in seven days or seventy hours in eight days, no record of duty status or
6		log book in possession, failing to retain previous seven-day record of duty status
7		or log book, or operating a vehicle with four to six out-of-service defects, one
8		hundred dollars;
9		b. False record of duty status or log book or operating a vehicle with seven to nine
0		out-of-service defects, two hundred fifty dollars;
11		c. Operating a vehicle after driver placed out of service, operating a vehicle with ter
2		or more out-of-service defects, or operating a vehicle that has been placed out of
3		service prior to its repair, five hundred dollars; and
4		d. All other violations of motor carrier safety rules adopted under subsection 3 of
5		section 39-21-46, fifty dollars.
6	7. 6.	On a highway on which the speed limit is posted in excess of sixty-five fifty-five miles
7		[104.61 kilometers][88.51 kilometers] an hour, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or
8		equivalent ordinance, a fee of five fifty dollars plus ten dollars for each mile per hour
9		over the limit.
20	8. 7.	For a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of
21		section 39-09-02, a fee of forty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the
22		posted speed; and forty dollars, plus one dollar for each additional mile per hour over
23		ten miles per hour over the limit unless a greater fee would be applicable under this
24		section.
25	9. 8.	For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of
26		section 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the
27		posted speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile per hour over ten miles
28		per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this section.
<u> 2</u> 9		The fee in this subsection does not apply to a highway construction zone unless
30		individuals engaged in construction are present at the time and place of the violation
31		and the posted speed limit sign states "Minimum Fee \$80".

- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-09-02 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - Subject to the provisions of section 39-09-01 and except in those instances when a lower speed is specified in this chapter, it presumably is lawful for the driver of a vehicle to drive the same at a speed not exceeding:
 - a. Twenty miles [32.19 kilometers] an hour when approaching within fifty feet [15.24 meters] of a grade crossing of any steam, electric, or street railway when the driver's view is obstructed. A driver's view is deemed to be obstructed when at any time during the last two hundred feet [60.96 meters] of the driver's approach to such crossing, the driver does not have a clear and uninterrupted view of such railway crossing and of any traffic on such railway for a distance of four hundred feet [121.92 meters] in each direction from such crossing.
 - b. Twenty miles [32.19 kilometers] an hour when passing a school during school recess or while children are going to or leaving school during opening or closing hours, unless a lower speed is designated or posted by local authorities.
 - c. Twenty miles [32.19 kilometers] an hour when approaching within fifty feet [15.24 meters] and in traversing an intersection of highways when the driver's view is obstructed. A driver's view is deemed to be obstructed when at any time during the last fifty feet [15.24 meters] of the driver's approach to such intersection, the driver does not have a clear and uninterrupted view of such intersection and of the traffic upon all of the highways entering such intersection for a distance of two hundred feet [60.96 meters] from such intersection.
 - d. Twenty miles [32.19 kilometers] an hour when the driver's view of the highway ahead is obstructed within a distance of one hundred feet [30.48 meters].
 - e. Twenty-five miles [40.23 kilometers] an hour on any highway in a business district or in a residence district or in a public park, unless a different speed is designated and posted by local authorities.
 - f. Fifty-five miles [88.51 kilometers] an hour on gravel, dirt, or loose surface highways, and on paved two-lane county and township highways if there is no speed limit posted, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by conditions.

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- g. Sixty-five miles [104.61 kilometers] an hour on paved two-lane highways if posted for that speed, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by conditions.

 h. Seventy miles [112.65 kilometers] an hour on paved and divided multilane
 - h. Seventy miles [112.65 kilometers] an hour on paved and divided multilane highways, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by conditions.
 - Seventy-five Eighty miles [120.70128.75 kilometers] an hour on access-controlled, paved and divided, multilane interstate highways, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by conditions.
