A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact <u>subdivision m of subsection 2 of section 62.1-02-05 and</u>
section 62.1-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to <u>possession of a firearm at a</u>

<u>public gathering and producing a concealed weapon license upon request.</u>

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision m of subsection 2 of section 62.1-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

m. A municipal court judge, a district court judge, a staff member of the office of attorney general, an elected official, and a retired North Dakota law enforcement officer, if the individual maintains the same level of firearms proficiency as is required by the peace officer standards and training board for law enforcement officers, and possesses a current class 2 concealed weapons permit. A local law enforcement agency shall issue a certificate of compliance under this section to an individual who is proficient.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 62.1-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

62.1-04-04. Producing license on demandupon request.

Every person while carrying a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon, for which a license to carry concealed is required, shall have on one's person the license issued by this or another state and shall give it to any law enforcement officer for an inspection upon demandrequest by the officer. The failure of any person to give the license to the officer is prima facie evidence that the person is illegally carrying a firearm or dangerous weapon concealed. If, within ten days of the alleged violation, the person produces satisfactory evidence of a valid license to carry a concealed weapon in effect at the time of the alleged violation of this section to the office of the
