- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the introduction of bills by executive branch agencies and the judicial
- 3 branch.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Introduction of bills by executive branch agencies and the judicial branch.</u>
- 8 <u>1. Except as otherwise provided in this section and sections 54-44.1-06, 54-44.1-06.1,</u>
 9 and 54-44.1-07, executive branch agencies and the judicial branch may not submit
- 10 <u>legislative bills for introduction to the legislative assembly.</u>
- 11 <u>2.</u> The judicial branch shall submit a bill including the budget request of the judicial
- branch to the legislative council within seven days after adjournment of each
- 13 <u>organizational session.</u>
- 14 3. An executive branch agency or the judicial branch may submit a legislative bill for
- introduction if requested by a legislative management committee or if requested or
- authorized by a standing committee of the legislative assembly. Any bill introduced
- 17 under this subsection must be deemed to be introduced by the legislative
- 18 <u>management or the standing committee that requested or authorized the introduction</u>
- 19 of the bill.
- 4. An executive branch agency or the judicial branch may request a member of the
- 21 legislative assembly to introduce a bill on behalf of the agency or the judicial branch. A
- bill introduced under this subsection by a member of the legislative assembly also
- 23 <u>must specify the name of the requesting entity.</u>
