- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-31 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to failure to vacate; to provide a penalty; to provide for an effective date;
- 3 and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-31 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows:

## 7 Failure to vacate - Penalty.

- 8 <u>1.</u> After a law enforcement officer has issued a lawful command to vacate, an individual
  9 may not willfully remain:
- 10 <u>a.</u> <u>On private or public property in violation of section 12.1-22-03;</u>
- 11 <u>b.</u> <u>On private or public property in violation of 12.1-31-01; or</u>
- 12c.In an environmentally sensitive area deemed possibly dangerous to the13individual's life, health, or safety.
- 14 <u>2.</u> <u>The failure of an individual to vacate under subsection 1, following a command to</u>
- 15 <u>vacate and after a reasonable time for vacating has elapsed, is prima facie evidence</u>
   16 <u>the individual is remaining willfully.</u>
- 17 <u>3.</u> As used in this section "environmentally sensitive area" means an area of land or
- 18 property which may experience imminent flooding, blizzard, or any other hazardous
- 19 <u>natural disaster.</u>
- A law enforcement officer shall cite an individual who violates this section with a fine of
   five thousand dollars for each violation.
- 22 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective March 1, 2017.
- 23 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
