4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 50-06-32 of the North Dakota Century 5 Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 The autism spectrum disorder task force consists of: 7 The state health officer, or the officer's designee; 8 (2) The director of the department of human services, or the director's 9 designee: 10 The director of special education superintendent of public instruction, or the 11 director's superintendent's designee; and 12 (4) The executive director of the protection and advocacy project, or the 13 director's designee; and 14 b. The following members appointed by the governor: 15 A pediatrician with expertise in the area of autism spectrum disorder; (1) 16 A psychologist with expertise in the area of autism spectrum disorder; (2) 17 A college of education faculty member with expertise in the area of autism (3) 18 spectrum disorder; 19 (4) A behavioral specialist; 20 (5) A licensed teacher with expertise in the area of autism spectrum disorder; 21 (5)(6) An occupational therapist; 22 A representative of a health insurance company doing business in this state; (6)(7) 23 (7)(8)A representative of a licensed residential care facility forthat provides care 24 and services to individuals with autism spectrum disorder;
