- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 and
- 2 section 43-26.1-05.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal history record
- 3 checks by the North Dakota board of physical therapy for physical therapist and physical
- 4 therapist assistant applicants and licensees.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 of the North Dakota
 7 Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 The North Dakota board of physical therapy for physical therapist and physical
- 9 therapist assistant applicants and for licensees under investigation, except that
- 10 <u>criminal history record checks need not be made unless required by the board.</u>

11 SECTION 2. Section 43-26.1-05.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

12 enacted as follows:

13 43-26.1-05.1. Use of criminal history record checks.

- 14 <u>The board may require a physical therapy or physical therapy assistant applicant, or a</u>
- 15 licensee under investigation, to submit to a statewide and nationwide criminal history record
- 16 <u>check. The criminal history record check must be conducted in the manner provided by section</u>
- 17 <u>12-60-24. The criminal history record check is an exempt record. All costs associated with a</u>
- 18 criminal history record check performed under this section are the responsibility of the applicant

19 <u>or licensee.</u>
