1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the information  
2 technology department; and to provide ~~for transfers~~ a report.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
7 other income, to the information technology department for the purpose of defraying the  
8 expenses of the information technology department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019,  
9 and ending June 30, 2021, as follows:
