1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state treasurer;
2 and to amend and reenact section 54-11-13 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the
3 salary of the state treasurer.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state treasurer for the purpose of defraying the
8 expenses of the state treasurer, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30,
9 2021, as follows:

1 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-11-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is
2 amended and reenacted as follows:

3 **54-11-13. Salary of state treasurer.**

4 The annual salary of the state treasurer is ~~ninety-six thousand nine hundred seventy-two~~
5 ~~dollars through June 30, 2016, and ninety-nine thousand eight hundred eighty-one dollars~~
6 ~~thereafter~~ one hundred seven thousand eight hundred eighty-five dollars through June 30, 2020,
7 and one hundred eleven thousand one hundred twenty-two dollars thereafter.
