## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

## 7 Freedom to teach strengths and weaknesses of scientific theories and controversies.

8 The state board of public school education, superintendent of public instruction, board of a

9 school district, each public school, administrators, teachers, and ancillary staff:

- 10 <u>1.</u> <u>May encourage students to explore scientific questions, learn about scientific</u>
- 11 evidence, and develop critical thinking skills regarding controversial issues;
- <u>May help students understand, analyze, critique, and review the scientific strengths</u>
   <u>and weaknesses of existing scientific theories and controversies; and</u>
- 14 <u>3.</u> <u>May not prohibit teachers from helping students understand, analyze, critique, and</u>
- review the scientific strengths and weaknesses of existing scientific theories and
   controversies.
