1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-10-15.4 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to intern embalmer applications and qualifications; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-10-15.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **43-10-15.4. Intern embalmer - Application - Qualifications.**

7 1. The board shall issue a certificate of registration as an intern embalmer to each
8 applicant who files an application upon a form and in a manner the board prescribes,
9 accompanied by a fee not to exceed fifty dollars, and who furnishes sufficient evidence
10 to the board that the applicant:

11 ~~1.~~ a. Is at least eighteen years of age;

12 ~~2.~~ b. Is of good moral character;

13 ~~3.~~ c. Has completed an accredited four-year high school course of study ~~and one year~~
14 ~~of accredited college or university studies;~~

15 d. Has completed one year of accredited college or university studies; and

16 e. Has been accepted to attend or is enrolled in an accredited college of mortuary
17 science, or has graduated from an accredited college of mortuary science.

18 2. An intern embalmer may not practice for more than six months before attending an
19 accredited college of mortuary science.

20 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
