## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2017

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the game and fish  
2 department; and to amend and reenact section 20.1-02-16.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
3 relating to the game and fish fund.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish fund in the state  
7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
8 other income, to the game and fish department for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the  
9 game and fish department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021,  
10 as follows:

17       **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding  
18 items approved by the sixty-fifth legislative assembly for the 2017-19 biennium:

24       **SECTION 3. GRANTS, GIFTS, AND DONATIONS LINE ITEM.** The grants, gifts, and  
25 donations line item in section 1 of this Act includes up to \$400,000 received by the game and  
26 fish department for surface damage, easements, or reclamation on department owned or  
27 managed properties as a result of mineral exploration and extraction activities.

28       **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-02-16.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
29 amended and reenacted as follows:

1           **20.1-02-16.1. Game and fish fund - Use - Required balance - Budget section approval.**

2           All income of the state game and fish department deposited by the director with the state  
3 treasurer must be credited to the state game and fish fund and the fund may be used only by  
4 the department. All money derived from the investment of the fund, special accounts, or  
5 portions of the fund must be credited to the game and fish department private land habitat and  
6 access improvement fund. The department shall spend moneys in the game and fish fund within  
7 the limits of legislative appropriations, only to the extent the balance of the fund is not reduced  
8 below fifteen million dollars, unless otherwise authorized by the budget section. Investment of  
9 up to fifteen million dollars of the balance of the game and fish fund may be made under the  
10 supervision of the state investment board and the moneys must be invested by the investing  
11 authority according to the laws relating to state investments. The department shall notify the  
12 state investment board of the amount available for investment.
