- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-07 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to requiring reasonable suspicion for certain traffic stops.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 5 and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>Halting requires reasonable suspicion.</u>
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a law enforcement officer or peace officer may
- 8 not halt an operator of a vehicle solely to determine compliance with section 39-08-01, or an
- 9 equivalent ordinance, unless the officer has a reasonable suspicion to believe there is a
- 10 <u>violation of section 39-08-01 or of an equivalent ordinance. This section does not apply to </u>
- 11 <u>inspections or safety checkpoints for commercial motor vehicles.</u>
