- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a road use fee for electric and hybrid vehicles.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

## 6 <u>Electric and hybrid vehicle road use fee - Definitions.</u>

- 7 <u>1.</u> In addition to all other fees required under this chapter for registration of a motor
- 8 vehicle, the department shall collect at the beginning of each annual registration
  9 period:
- 10a.An electric vehicle road use fee of two hundred forty-eight dollars for each11electric vehicle registered.
- 12 <u>b.</u> <u>A hybrid vehicle road use fee of seventy-one dollars for each hybrid vehicle</u>
   13 <u>registered.</u>
- 14 <u>2.</u> <u>As used in this section:</u>
- a. "Electric vehicle" means a vehicle propelled by an electric motor powered by a
  battery or other electric device incorporated into the vehicle and not propelled by
  an engine powered by the combustion of a hydrocarbon fuel, including gasoline,
  diesel, propane, or liquid natural gas.
- 19b."Hybrid vehicle" means a vehicle drawing propulsion energy from both an internal20combustion engine and an energy storage device and employing a regenerative21braking system to recover waste energy to charge the energy storage device

22 providing propulsion energy.

23 <u>3.</u> The department shall deposit any moneys collected under this section into the
24 highway tax distribution fund.
