- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-44.3-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to exceptions to classified service.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.3-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 54-44.3-20. Categories of positions in the state service.

- 7 All positions in the state service are included in the classified service, except:
- Each official elected by popular vote and each person appointed to fill vacancies in an
 elective office, one principal assistant, and one private secretary.
- 10 2. Members of boards and commissions required by law.
- 1 3. Administrative heads of departments required by law, other than the superintendent of
- North Dakota vision services school for the blind, the superintendent of the school for
 the deaf, and the state librarian.
- 14 4. Officers and employees of the legislative branch of government.
- 15 5. Members of the judicial branch of government of the state of North Dakota and their16 employees and jurors.
- 17 6. Persons temporarily employed in a professional or scientific capacity as consultants or
- 18 to conduct a temporary and special inquiry, investigation, or examination for the
- 19 legislative branch of government or a department of the state government.
- 20 7. Positions deemed to be inappropriate to the classified service due to the special21 nature of the position as determined by the division and approved by the board.
- 8. Employees of the institutions of higher education under the control of the state boardof higher education.
- 9. Members and employees of occupational and professional boards.

- 1 10. Officers and employees of the North Dakota mill and elevator association.
- 2 11. Positions referred to under law as serving at the pleasure of or at the will of the3 appointing authority.
- 4 12. Licensed teachers engaged in teaching at the North Dakota youth correctional center,
- 5 North Dakota vision services school for the blind, and the school for the deaf.
- 6 13. Officers of workforce safety and insurance.
- 7 14. Officers and employees of the department of commerce.
- 8 15. Attorneys employed by the insurance commissioner.
- 9 16. Engineers, engineering technicians, and geologists employed by the director of
 10 mineral resources.
