- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact chapter 8-12 and section 39-01-01.2 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to automated vehicle network companies and autonomous vehicle
- 3 operations; and to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-06.1-08 of the North Dakota
- 4 Century Code, relating to nonmoving violations.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 8-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as 7 follows:
- 8 <u>8-12-01</u>. Definitions.
- 9 As used in the chapter:
- 10 <u>1.</u> "Autonomous vehicle" means a vehicle equipped with an automated driving system.
- 11 <u>2.</u> "Client" means a person requesting service from an on-demand autonomous vehicle
- network. The term includes a passenger, a shipper, as defined by section 41-07-02, a
- person entitled under the document, as defined by section 41-07-02, or similar
- individual or commercial enterprise.
- 15 <u>3. "On-demand autonomous vehicle network" means a transportation service network</u>
- that uses a software application or other digital means to dispatch or otherwise enable
- the prearrangement of transportation with autonomous vehicles for purposes of
- transporting persons or goods, including for-hire transportation, transportation for
- 19 <u>compensation, and public transportation.</u>

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- 21 <u>1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person may operate an on-demand</u>
- 22 <u>autonomous vehicle network. An on-demand autonomous vehicle network may</u>
- provide transportation of persons or goods, including:

8	<u>3.</u>	<u>Unl</u>	ess otherwise provided in this chapter and notwithstanding any other provision of

11		<u>a.</u>	A state agency or political subdivision may not impose requirements, including		
12			performance standards specific to the operation of an autonomous vehicle or		
13			automated driving systems without human drivers in compliance with		
14			subsection 3 of section 39-01-01.2.		
15		<u>b.</u>	A state or local agency or political subdivision may not impose a tax, fee, or other		
16			requirement specific to the operation of an autonomous vehicle that is in		
17			compliance with subsection 3 of section 39-01-01.2, an automated driving		
18			system, or an on-demand vehicle network. This prohibition does not affect vehicle		
19			registration and titling fees otherwise required by law.		
20	SECTION 2. Section 39-01-01.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted

23	<u>1.</u>	As	used in this section:		
24		<u>a.</u>	"Automated driving system" means hardware and software collectively capable of		
25			performing the entire dynamic driving task for the vehicle on a sustained basis		
26			when installed on a motor vehicle and engaged regardless of whether it is limited		
27			to a specific operational design domain.		
28		<u>b.</u>	"Autonomous vehicle" means a vehicle equipped with an automated driving		
29			system.		
30		<u>C.</u>	"Dynamic driving task" means all of the real-time operational and tactical		
31			functions required to operate a vehicle in on-road traffic within the vehicle's		

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1			specific operational design domain, if any, excluding the strategic functions such
2			as trip scheduling and selection of destinations and waypoints.
3		<u>d.</u>	"Human driver" means an individual with a valid license to operate a motor
4			vehicle who controls all or part of the dynamic driving task.
5		<u>e.</u>	"Minimal risk condition" means a low-risk operating mode in which an
6			autonomous vehicle operating without a human driver achieves a reasonably
7			safe state, such as bringing the vehicle to a complete stop, upon experiencing a
8			failure of the vehicle's automated driving system that renders the vehicle unable
9			to perform the entire dynamic driving task.
10		<u>f.</u>	"Operational design domain" means a description of the specific operating
11			domain in which an automated driving system is designed to properly operate,
12			including roadway types, speed range, environmental conditions, and other
13			domain constraints.
14		<u>g.</u>	"Operator" means an individual who drives or is in actual physical control of a
15			motor vehicle upon a highway or who is exercising control over or steering a
16			vehicle being towed by a motor vehicle.
17	<u>2.</u>	An a	autonomous vehicle must be capable of operating in compliance with all applicable
18		fede	eral and state law, except to the extent exempted under applicable federal or state
19		law,	and may operate on the public highways of this state in full compliance with all
20		<u>veh</u>	icle registration, title, insurance, and all other applicable requirements under this
21		title	<u>.</u>
22	<u>3.</u>	<u>An a</u>	autonomous vehicle with automated driving systems engaged does not require a
23		<u>hun</u>	nan driver to operate on the public highway relevant to the vehicle's intended
24		<u>ope</u>	rational design domain. An individual using an autonomous vehicle in which the
25		auto	omated driving system is completing the entire dynamic driving task is not driving
26		<u>or ir</u>	n actual physical control of the autonomous vehicle and, therefore, is exempt from
27		lice	nsing requirements.
