1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 25-06 and a new section to 2 chapter 25-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal history record checks; and 3 to amend and reenact paragraph 5 of subdivision x of subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 and 4 paragraph 5 of subdivision y of subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 of the North Dakota Century 5 Code, relating to criminal history record checks.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Paragraph 5 of subdivision x of subsection 2 of section 8 12-60-24 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 9 The superintendent of public instruction in the case of a nonpublic school or 10 a state school with a superintendent appointed by or reporting to the 11 superintendent of public instruction, for employees designated by the 12 nonpublic or state school, provided the nonpublic or state school is 13 responsible for paying the costs associated with obtaining a criminal history 14 record check. 15 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Paragraph 5 of subdivision y of subsection 2 of section 16 12-60-24 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 17 The superintendent of public instruction in the case of a nonpublic school or 18 a state school with a superintendent appointed by or reporting to the 19 superintendent of public instruction, for a final applicant seeking 20 employment with the school or otherwise providing services to the school, if 21 that individual has unsupervised contact with students, provided the board is 22 responsible for paying the costs associated with obtaining a criminal history 23 record check.

1 SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 25-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 2 and enacted as follows: 3 Criminal history record checks. 4 The school for the blind may require any employee, final applicant for employment, or any 5 individual otherwise providing services to the school to submit to a statewide and nationwide 6 criminal history record check. The nationwide criminal history record check must be conducted 7 in the manner provided in section 12-60-24. The school for the blind may assess all costs 8 associated with obtaining a criminal history record check to the individual upon whom the 9 criminal history record check is conducted. 10 SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 25-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 11 and enacted as follows: 12 Criminal history record checks. 13 The school for the deaf may require any employee, final applicant for employment, or any 14 individual otherwise providing services to the school to submit to a statewide and nationwide 15 criminal history record check. The nationwide criminal history record check must be conducted 16 in the manner provided in section 12-60-24. The school for the deaf may assess all costs 17 associated with obtaining a criminal history record check to the individual upon whom the 18 criminal history record check is conducted.
