- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-22-18 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to retail motor vehicle sales.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-22-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 39-22-18. Renewal of dealer license Fees Minimum sales requirement Penalty.
- A dealer license issued under this chapter expires on December thirty-first of each year. A
- 8 licensed dealer may apply for renewal of the dealer's license on forms prescribed by the
- 9 department and payment of the dealer license and dealer plate fees required by this chapter.
- 10 The department shallmay not renew the dealer license of any applicant who has made less than
- 11 foureight retail motor vehicle sales during the previous year. The department may adopt
- 12 administrative rules to limit the number of dealer plates available to an applicant based on the
- applicant's motor vehicle sales history. Any dealer who fails to submit a renewal application
- 14 before the expiration of the dealer's current license, in addition to all other fees due, shall pay a
- one hundred dollar fee at the time the dealer's license is renewed. For purposes of this section,
- 16 "retail motor vehicle sales" means the sale of a motor vehicle that requires titling and
- 17 registration in order to operate on the roads.
