HB 1032 creates a new chapter under 26.1 which requires prescription drug cost transparency by analyzing data on various drugs and posting information on a state website.

The Board of Pharmacy may deposit money based on licensing fees into an account associated with the Insurance Department.

1032 creates a continuing appropriation. Utilizing revenues from fees assessed by the Board of Pahrarmacy, the Insurance Department will make expenditures to hire consultants to analyse the data that manufacturers are required to provide, and create a website on which this data will be provided to the public.

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
