- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-66 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to written advisory opinions regarding ethics.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-66 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Advisory opinions Authority Effect.
- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>In response to a request from a public official, candidate for elected office, or lobbyist, </u>
- 8 <u>the ethics commission may provide a written advisory opinion regarding the</u>
- 9 application of the following to specified hypothetical facts or prospective conduct:
- 10 a. Article XIV of the Constitution of North Dakota; or
- b. State statutes and ethics commission rules related to transparency, corruption,
 elections, and lobbying.
- 13 <u>2.</u> Within fourteen days after receiving a request for a written advisory opinion, the ethics
 14 commission shall notify the requester whether an opinion will be provided.
- 3. Within ninety days after notifying a requester that a written advisory opinion will be
 issued, the ethics commission shall issue the opinion.
- 4. Criminal and civil penalties may not be imposed upon an individual for an action taken
 in accordance with an opinion issued under this section if:
 - a. The individual acts in good faith; and

- 20 <u>b.</u> The material facts surrounding the action taken are substantially the same as the
 21 <u>conduct presented in the opinion.</u>
- 5. Opinions and requests for opinions under this section are open records, except names
 of persons in the opinions and requests are exempt records.

- 1 <u>6.</u> The ethics commission shall publish all written advisory opinions issued under this
- 2 section on a website that is accessible to the public.
