1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 54-44.4 and subsection 3 of

2 section 54-44.4-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to payments for purchases,

3 communication with elected officials, and the procurement information website; and to amend

4 and reenact subsection 7 of section 54-44.4-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to

5 emergency purchases.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
8 and enacted as follows:

## Elected officials - Bidder - Communication.

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the The office of management and budget may-

11 <u>not restrict communication between ashall develop guidelines for a person interested in</u>

12 <u>conducting business with the state. The guidelines must address communications between</u>

13 interested persons and purchasing agencies before, during, and after the procurement process.

14 Procurements conducted by the office of management and budget or a purchasing agency must

15 have a procurement officer who serves as the point of contact for all correspondence related to

16 the procurement. A person that is interested in submitting a bid or has submitted a bid or

17 proposal to provide commodities or services to the state and any in response to an active

18 procurement should ensure all communications related to the procurement are only with the

- 19 designated point of contact. This section does not restrict an interested person's communication
- 20 with state official officials or any member of the legislative assembly unless the state official or
- 21 member of the legislative assembly is involved directly with the procurement for which the
- 22 person is interested or has submitted a bid or proposal. This section does not apply to-
- 23 <u>communication with a state official directly involved with a bid under consideration.</u>

22			procurement file a written determination of the basis for the noncompetitive	
23			purchase, including the circumstances that justified the noncompetitive purchase.	
24		d.	If the emergency purchase is subject to federal funding reimbursement, the office	
25			of management and budget or the purchasing agency shall ensure the	
26			procurement procedures and documentation are adequate to satisfy	
27			requirements for federal reimbursement.

29			require a sample for use in determining whether an offered product meets

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1	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created			
2	and enacted as follows:			
3	<u>Purchases - Payment <del>- Commodity</del>.</u>			
4	The purchasing agency shall payand the vendor may negotiate payment terms for all			
5	commodities within thirty days of receipt of an invoice and services procured. If a date for			
6	payment is not specified by the contract, payment must be made pursuant to section			
7	<u>13-01.1-01.</u>			
8	SECTION 4. Subsection 3 of section 54-44.4-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
9	created and enacted as follows:			
10	3. The office of management and budget shall establish and maintain a standardized-bid-			
11	procedure for the submission of electronic bids and proposals through the			
12	procurement information website. The procedure must minimize the length of a			
13	solicitation for bid and include only the unique specifications related to the commodity			
14	or service sought The office of management and budget, in consultation with the office			
15	of the attorney general, shall develop standardized solicitation documents. The			
16	documents must be made available on the procurement information website. When			
17	drafting a solicitation, the office of management and budget and purchasing agencies			
18	shall use their best efforts to minimize the length of the solicitation by ensuring only			
19	those sections from the standardized solicitation documents applicable to the			
20	procurement are included.
