1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 54-44.4 and subsection 3 of

2 section 54-44.4-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to payments for purchases,

3 communication with elected officials, and the procurement information website; and to amend

4 and reenact subsection 7 of section 54-44.4-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to

5 emergency purchases.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
8 and enacted as follows:

9 <u>Elected officials - Bidder - Communication.</u>

10 <u>The office of management and budget shall develop guidelines for a person interested in</u>

11 <u>conducting business with the state. The guidelines must address communications between</u>

12 interested persons and purchasing agencies before, during, and after the procurement process.

13 Procurements conducted by the office of management and budget or a purchasing agency must

14 have a procurement officer who serves as the point of contact for all correspondence related to

15 the procurement. A person that is interested in submitting a bid or has submitted a bid or

16 proposal to provide commodities or services to the state in response to an active procurement

17 should ensure all communications related to the procurement are only with the designated point

18 of contact. This section does not restrict an interested person's communication with state

19 officials or any member of the legislative assembly unless the state official or member of the

20 legislative assembly is involved directly with the procurement for which the person is interested

21 or has submitted a bid or proposal.

22 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 54-44.4-02 of the North Dakota

23 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

11			(2) <u>The basis for</u> the selection of the particular contractor must be included in

13		<u>C.</u>	If the emergency circumstances warrant a noncompetitive purchase, the office of
14			management and budget or the purchasing agency shall document within the
15			procurement file a written determination of the basis for the noncompetitive
16			purchase, including the circumstances that justified the noncompetitive purchase.
17		<u>d.</u>	If the emergency purchase is subject to federal funding reimbursement, the office
18			of management and budget or the purchasing agency shall ensure the
19			procurement procedures and documentation are adequate to satisfy
20			requirements for federal reimbursement.
21		<u>e.</u>	If time allows, emergency purchases for commodities under this subsection may
22			require a sample for use in determining whether an offered product meets
23			specifications.

1	<u>3.</u>	The office of management and budget shall establish and maintain a standardized
2		procedure for the submission of electronic bids and proposals through the
3		procurement information website. The office of management and budget, in
4		consultation with the office of the attorney general, shall develop standardized
5		solicitation documents. The documents must be made available on the procurement
6		information website. When drafting a solicitation, the office of management and budget
7		and purchasing agencies shall use their best efforts to minimize the length of the
8		solicitation by ensuring only those sections from the standardized solicitation
9		documents applicable to the procurement are included.
