- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-21-02.4 and 15.1-21-02.5 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to eligibility for the North Dakota career and technical education
- 3 scholarship and the North Dakota academic scholarship for high school students enrolled in
- 4 school districts using course proficiency-based grading systems.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-21-02.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 15.1-21-02.4. North Dakota career and technical education scholarship. (Effective through July 31, 2021)
  - Any resident student who graduates from a high school during or after the 2010-11 school year and any resident student who completes a program of home education supervised in accordance with chapter 15.1-23 during or after the 2012-13 school year is eligible to receive a North Dakota career and technical education scholarship provided the student:
- Completed four units of English language arts from a sequence that includes literature,
  composition, and speech;
- 16 2. Completed three units of mathematics, including:
  - a. One unit of algebra II, as defined by the superintendent of public instruction; and
- 18b. Two units of any other mathematics, which may include one unit of computerscience;
- 20 3. Completed three units of science, consisting of:
- a. (1) One unit of biology;
- 22 (2) One unit of chemistry; and
- 23 (3) One unit of physics; or
- b. (1) One unit of biology;
