1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the

2 secretary of state and public printing; to amend and reenact section 54-09-05 of the North

3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the secretary of state; and to provide an

4 exemption.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending
June 30, 2023, as follows:

23	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is					
24	amended and reenacted as follows:					
25	54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state.					
26	The annual salary of the secretary of state is one hundred seventwelve thousand eighttwo					
27	hundred eighty-fiveforty-one dollars through June 30, <del>20202021</del> , and one hundred tenfourteen					
28	thousand fivefour hundred eighty-twoeighty-six dollars thereafter.					
29	SECTION 5. TRIBAL GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. Of the funds					
30	appropriated in the grants line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, \$25,000 is from the					
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- 1 general fund for the purpose of providing grants to each federally recognized tribal government
- 2 located within the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. The
- 3 secretary of state may provide grants in an amount up to \$5,000 to each tribal government to
- 4 reimburse administrative costs incurred by each tribal government to issue addresses and
- 5 identifications for voting purposes.
