- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the game and fish
- 2 department; to provide a report; to provide for a transfer; and to provide an exemption.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the game and fish department for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the game and fish department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

14	committees of the sixty-eighth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the				
15	biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.				
16	SECTION 3. GRANTS, GIFTS, AND DONATIONS LINE ITEM. The grants, gifts, and				
17	donations line item in section 1 of this Act includes up to \$100,000 received by the game and				
18	fish department for surface damage, easements, or reclamation on department-owned or				
19	managed properties as a result of mineral exploration and extraction activities.				
20	SECTION 4. EXEMPTION - LINE ITEM TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04,				
21	the director of the office of management and budget shall transfer up to \$3,261,237 of				
22	2 appropriation authority between the operating expenses, capital assets, and grants - game and				
23	3 fish line items in section 1 of this Act as requested by the game and fish department during the				
24	biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. The game and fish department				
25	shall notify the legislative council of any transfers made pursuant to this section.
